Year 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Printing methods: layered printing with polystyrene. • To print using more than one colour. • To design their own print. • To print onto different materials. • To use key vocabulary to demonstrate knowledge and understanding.
Year 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Printing methods: lino printing. • To design and create printing blocks/tiles. • To print onto different materials. • To develop techniques in lino printing. • To use key vocabulary to demonstrate knowledge and understanding.
Year 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Printing methods: lino printing. • To design and create printing blocks/tiles. • To print onto different materials. • To continue to develop techniques in lino printing. • To use their knowledge of printing to make decisions to perfect their design. • To draw inspiration from other artists and discuss influences on their work.
