The children will continue to learn phase 2 sounds and consolidate all other sounds applying to reading and spelling CVC words such as 'mat'. We will read texts such as; 'Supertato', 'Superworm', 'ABC Heroes' and 'The Nativity.' We will learn to orally retell stories and apply sounds to writing labels and captions.

### Maths.

We will learn about representing numbers and counting quantities. We will explore 2D shapes and positional language.

The children will also begin to develop an understanding of time through night and day.

# Personal, Social and Emotional Development:
