Welcome to Rabbit Class!

Our new learning theme for this half term is...

“Is it ever sunny in the Arctic and Antarctica?”

Our focus will be on Antarctica, and we will be finding out about explorers and polar animals. Most of our learning will be linked to our main theme, although some subjects i.e. Maths, will continue to be taught separately.

We hope to have an exciting half term of learning!

In English, we will start this half term by using ‘*The Rainbow Bear*’ as our main text and focusing on setting descriptions and diary writing. After that, we will be using non-fiction books to help us to write fact-files on a polar animal.

In Maths, we will continue with addition and subtraction work this half term by using number lines and different mental strategies to add and subtract larger numbers.

We will also be recognising and describing 2D and 3D shapes at the end of this half term.

P.E. this half term will focus on ‘Principles of Play’ and will continue to be on **Tuesday** afternoons. Please ensure your child comes to school wearing their P.E. kit on Tuesdays.
