CHICKEN POX



We wanted to make you aware that we have had several recent cases of chickenpox within the school.

Chickenpox is a common childhood illness, but it spreads very easily. A person with chickenpox can be contagious from two days before the spots appear until all the spots have scabbed over, which usually takes about five days after they first appear. Because children are most contagious before any visible signs, it can spread quickly without warning with the spots usually appearing between 7 to 21 days after contact with the virus.

If your child develops symptoms, we recommend keeping them at home and consulting NHS guidance.

PE UNIFORM

You may have seen in the news this week that the Department for Education has announced plans to reduce the number of compulsory branded items in school uniforms. At The Pines, we have always prioritised keeping uniform costs as low as possible, ensuring our uniform remains affordable and widely available and therefore these changes do not affect us directly.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the PE kit expectations for all pupils. Our PE kit can be purchased easily from most major supermarkets or online retailers and should consist of:

- Plain white T-shirt
- Navy or black shorts or cycle shorts
- Suitable trainers or plimsolls

On PE days, pupils should also wear their school jumper over their PE kit. Please note that branded sportswear, including football kits or logoed T-shirts, is not permitted.
