Most of our learning will be linked to our main theme, although some subjects i.e. Maths, will continue to be taught separately.

In **English** we will be looking at Shakespeare's plays and how the language was used in comparison to now. As well as reading Treason by Berlie Doherty.

This links with our **history** topic of 'Tudor life', as the later period saw the flowering of the arts, especially the theatre and the plays of Shakespeare.

We will also explore King Henry VIII and Queen Elizabeth I during this topic.

Our maths learning will cover:

- position and direction
- negative numbers
- converting units
- volume

In **science** this half term we are going to be continuing with our learning on forces.

In **French** we will cover rooms in a house and activities people do at home.
