## P.E.

PE will be on Tuesday and Friday afternoons, so please ensure your child wears their P.E. kit to school on Tuesday and Friday. We will be learning about Invasion Games and Athletics.

## Maths

In Maths, we will start this half term looking at time. We will recap telling time to o'clock and half past before moving on to look at quarter past/to the hour. We will also start to look at writing the time to the nearest 5 minutes. We will then move onto look at statistics. The children will interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables. We will also be answering simple questions about these.

## English

In English, we will be exploring persuasive writing using the book 'Fish' by Brendan Kearney. The children will be looking at the story and planning and writing persuasive letters. We will also be using the book 'Flotsam' by David Wiesner to recap and develop our punctuation and grammar this half term. Finally, we will be writing recounts about our trip to Wandlebury.

## Curriculum

In Science, we will be learning about animals their young and life cycles.

Our Theme we will be looking at what a coast is and identifying human and physical features. We will also be looking at how people use the coast.

## R.E, RSE & Music
