As part of our planning consent, we are required to ensure a biodiversity net gain across the site. To support this work, we have partnered with a specialist from the charity Plant Life, who recently visited the school to survey the existing conditions and help guide the most suitable approach for our site. As part of these efforts, children from The Pines and Pine Cones have also been busy planting wildflowers to encourage more biodiversity and support local habitats.

for a small prize!




#### Winter Fair Raffle
