Our new learning this half term is...

We will also be using a variety of books to continue our focus on reading skills.

How to help your child at home

Reading for a least 5 minutes each day - Parents recording a short note in their reading record.

Practise any sounds or sounds your child is struggling with at least 3 times a week.

Practise reading and spelling the tricky words/common exception words.
