### Maths:

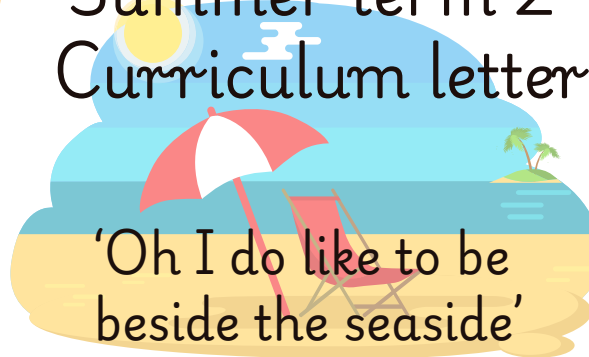
Our Summer 2 maths topics will include; Geometry, time and money.
